## **Fr. Pacwa**

### **Who is Fr. Mitch Pacwa?**

Fr. Mitch is one of the most popular Catholic speakers in the world. He appears weekly on EWTN Global Catholic Television and Radio. He is fluent in 12 languages. He is the Founder & President, of Ignatius Productions, a Catholic media production apostolate, whose mission is to teach people the scriptures, educate Catholics about their Faith, and promote unity and understanding within the Mystical Body of Christ.

### **What will he be speaking about?**

In celebration of the “Year for Priests”, the theme of the day will be, “*Jesus Christ – Our One True High Priest*”. The day will include 3 talks:

1. Talk 1 – Our Call to be Faithful
2. Talk 2 – In the Order of Melchizedek
3. Talk 3 – Jesus Christ, Our High Priest in the Holy of Holies

## **Registration**

### **Is there a cost?**

Yes. Registration is \$10 and includes a boxed lunch.

### **How do I register?**

Fill out the Event Registration Form on the bottom of the flyer that has been in the bulletin and either drop it off at the Parish Business Office or mail it with a check (\$10 per person) made out to St. Gregory Parish.

### **I don't have a Registration Form; where can I get one?**

They are available at the Parish Business Office or available to download and print on the St. Gregory the Great Parish Website at: [www.saintgregoryparish.org](http://www.saintgregoryparish.org)

### **Can I Register over the phone?**

Yes, but the Registration will not be complete until we receive the \$10 per person fee.

### **How will I know that I am officially registered?**

We will mail out your confirmation letter on March 1st, which will include your ticket(s) and directions to St. Gregory the Great Parish.

### **Are there a limited number of seats? Will this sell out?**

We will only register approximately 750 people, which will fill the Church. Once we have received that number of completed Registrations, we will no longer take Registrations.

### **Will you accept walk-up registrations the day of the event?**

If the event is not sold out, we will accept registrations the day of the event for \$5 per person with no boxed lunch.

### **I have young children, do I have to pay for them?**

Children 6 years of age or younger are free, but will not be given a lunch. Please inform us of the number of children 6 years or younger, so we can have enough space. You can always choose to register your child and pay \$10, which would guarantee a lunch.

### **What will be included in the boxed lunch?**

Your choice of a ham or turkey sandwich, chips, a cookie and a bottle of water.

## **General Questions**

### **What will I need to bring with me to the event?**

You will need to bring the ticket(s) that will be mailed to you in the confirmation letter that will go out March 1st. Tickets will be color coded to tell us your lunch preference – ham, turkey or no lunch. You may also choose to bring a rosary to participate in several devotions throughout the event.

**Will Fr. Mitch be selling books and/or videos?**

Yes. He will have a table set up in the Parish Family Center (PFC) with a complete assortment of his resources. He accepts cash, checks, Visa, MasterCard and Discover. This will be open during the lunch break (11:30AM-1:00PM) and after the event from 3:30-5:00PM.

**Will the 9:00AM Mass at the event on Saturday, cover my Sunday obligation?**

No, but St. Gregory the Great offers a Vigil Mass on Saturday afternoon at 5:00PM.

**Will I have the opportunity to go to Confession?**

After the event, Confessions will be offered in the main Church from 3:30-4:30PM.

**Will you offer Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament?**

St. Gregory the Great Parish is blessed to offer Perpetual Adoration in a Chapel inside the Main Church (near the vestibule), which will be open throughout the event. All are welcome to Adore Our Lord!

**Is this event Handicap Accessible?**

Yes, but the lunch break will take place in the Parish Family Center (PFC), which will require going outside for a short walk.

**Directions to St. Gregory the Great**

These will be included in the Confirmation Letter of your Registration.

**From I-271 North or South**

- Exit I-271 at Cedar-Brainard Rd. (exit #32)
- Follow signs to Cedar Rd. – West
- Travel on Cedar Rd. heading West (for approx. 2 miles):
  - ~ You will pass Beachwood Mall on your left.
  - ~ You will pass Richmond Rd. (continue on Cedar Rd.)
  - ~ You will pass Legacy Village on your right.
- Turn RIGHT on S. Green Rd. (for approx. 1 mile)
  - ~ You will pass Notre Dame College of Ohio on your right.
  - ~ You will pass Regina High School on your right.
  - ~ You will pass University Suburban Medical Center on your right.
- St. Gregory the Great Parish will be 1/8 of a mile past the University Suburban Medical Center on your right. Address is 1545 S. Green Rd., South Euclid, OH 44121. Just south of the intersection of Mayfield Rd. & Green Rd.
